Plant Operator

REPORTS TO: **Works Supervisor/ Labour Manager**

Overall Job Purpose:

As Plant Operator, you will operate piling plant to construct driven sheet piles/tubes/CFA piles; which should be carried out in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and procedures.

Main Responsibilities and Duties:

- Effectively, diligently and with careful consideration, safely operate the machinery to deliver maximum productive efficiency
- Regularly maintain the machinery & keep suitably detailed, timely accurate records
- Assist others in major servicing and repairs
- Keep the machinery in a clean and tidy condition
- To operate the machinery safely and within its limits in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions
- To only work under the direct control of your Nominated Banksman within an established Controlled Exclusion zone
- To follow the directions of the Nominated Banksman for all plant movements. Ensuring that you do not make any plant movement unless instructed to by the Nominated Banksman
- To install piles in accordance with the construction issue information provided for your use by site management (e.g. drawings and schedules)
- To be proficient in the use of the piling rig instrumentation system, to accurately carry out essential routine data entry and regular calibration operations
- Ensure the Quality of the constructed Works complies with the agreed Specification and, where you are aware it does not, immediately raise potential Non Conformities with the Works Supervisor
- To carry out, report and accurately record the regular daily and weekly checks on the piling rig and the condition of piling attachments (e.g. hammers etc.).
- Completion of daily/weekly inspections and ensure this is issued to Head Office on a weekly basis
- To ensure the rig is kept clean and in a good, tidy condition at all times. Maintain all access ways, handrails, etc. in a safe and clear condition
- Ensure all plant is refuelled prior to off hire and collection
- To carry out/assist in rigging up and de-rigging of the rig
- To carry out any other suitable duties, tasks or work elements as reasonably required and instructed by management
- To always act with zero tolerance of unsafe working practices, behaviours, conditions and plant
- To report Hazard and Near Misses accurately and at the earliest stage
- To promote a positive Company image to all stakeholders
- Ensure all appropriate PPE is worn at all times
- To understand and ensure that the Works are carried out strictly in accordance with the approved Project specific: Method Statements, Task Sheets, Risk Assessments, Lift Plan, Inspection and Test Plan

General Company Responsibilities and Duties:

- Personal and team adherence to existing working practices, methods and procedures, undertake relevant training and development activities and respond positively to new and alternative systems

- Proactive approach to Health Safety and Environment and co-operate with the Company's HSEQ Manager with relevant Health, Safety and Environment legislation, policies, and processes
- Maintain confidentiality and observe data protection and associated guidelines where appropriate
